

A Minor Piano Chord (Am)

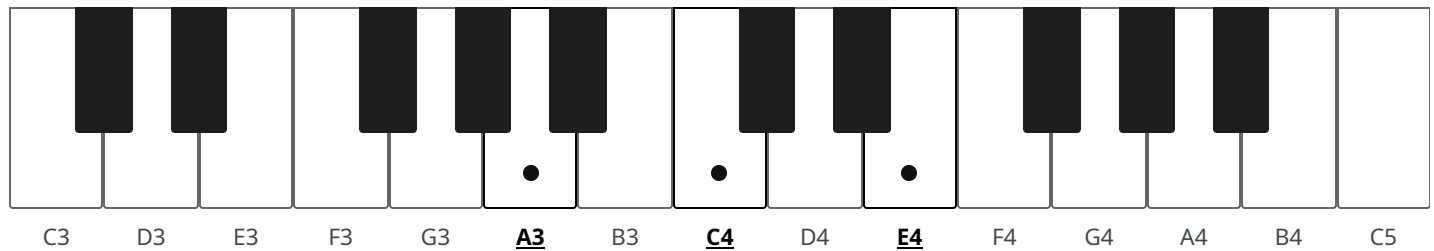
Chord tones: A–C–E · Formula: 1, $\flat 3$, 5

A3 – C4 – E4

Bass: A3

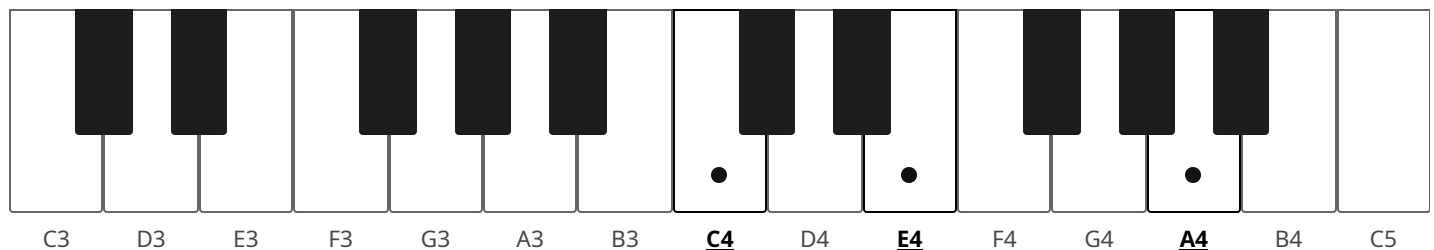


First inversion

C4 – E4 – A4

Am/C

Bass: C4

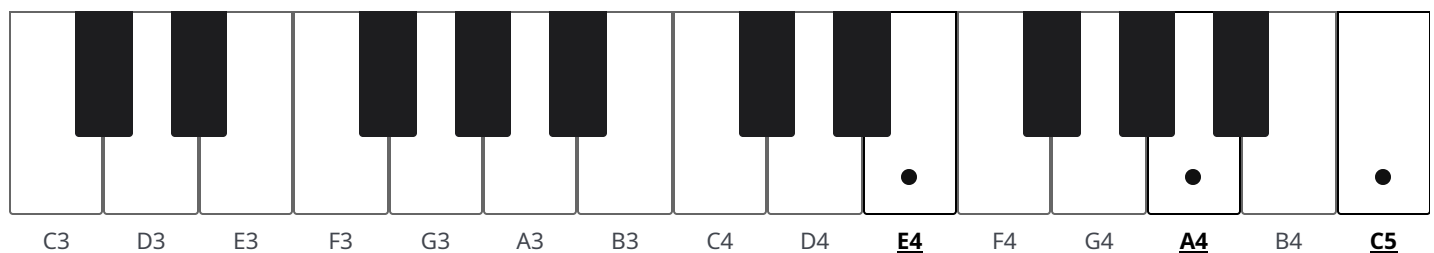


Second inversion

E4 – A4 – C5

Am/E

Bass: E4



Dots mark notes to play. C4 is middle C. Numbers identify octaves, not fingers.

The marked keys show pitches, not a hand shape or a required fingering.
