

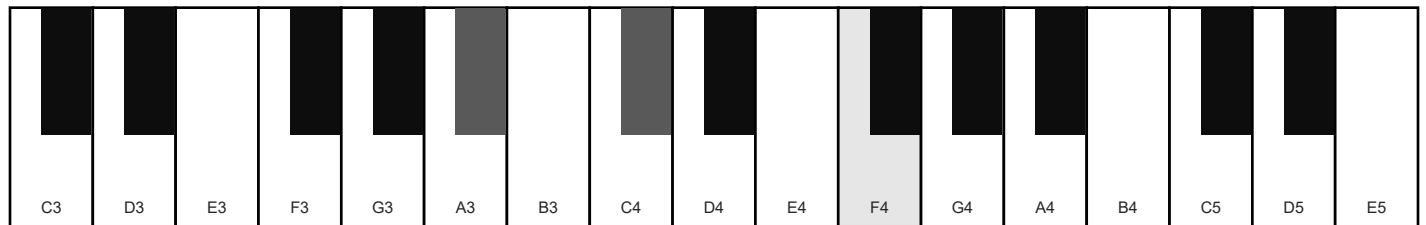

Root position · B $\flat$ m

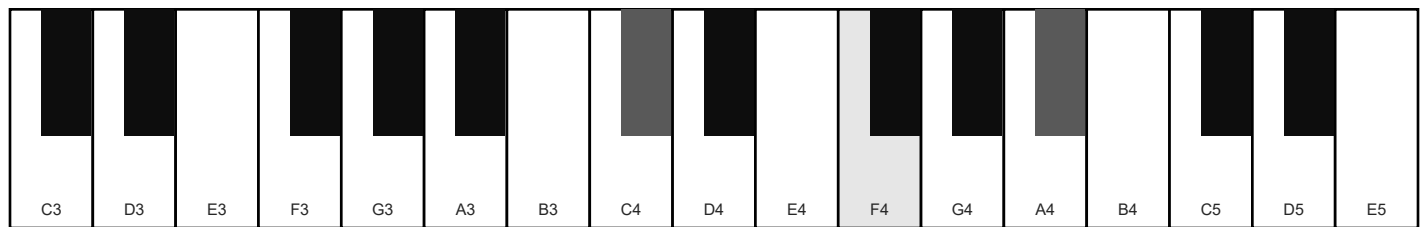
Bass: B $\flat$ 3

First inversion · B $\flat$ m/D $\flat$

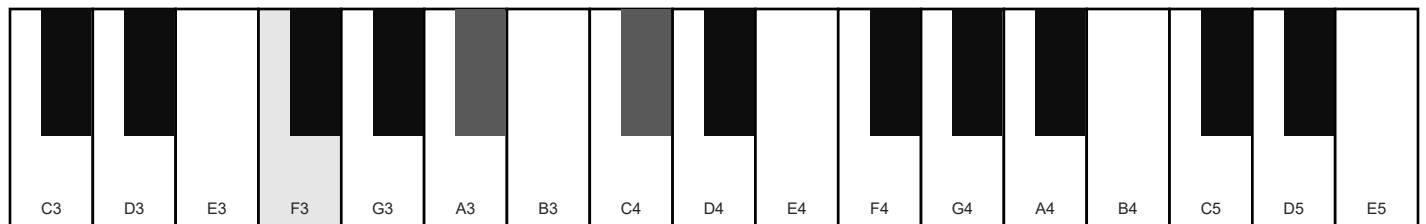
Bass: D $\flat$ 4



Selected pitches: D $\flat$ 4 · F4 · B $\flat$ 4

Second inversion · B $\flat$ m/F

Bass: F3



Selected pitches: F3 · B $\flat$ 3 · D $\flat$ 4

Dots and shading mark the sounding keys. Octave numbers are not finger numbers.

Each example keeps the chord tones but may use a different register.

No staff notation or hand-specific finger numbers are included in this PDF.

Keyboard window: C3–E5. Fingering is intentionally not assigned.
