Three positions of the same triad. Labels show written pitches; octaves follow scientific pitch notation.

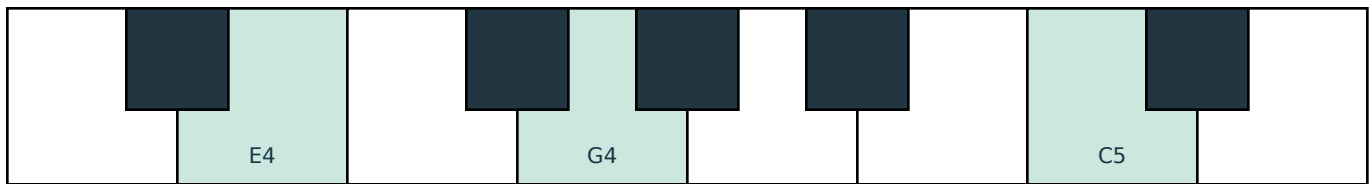
Root position • C

Notes: C4 – E4 – G4 Lowest note: C4



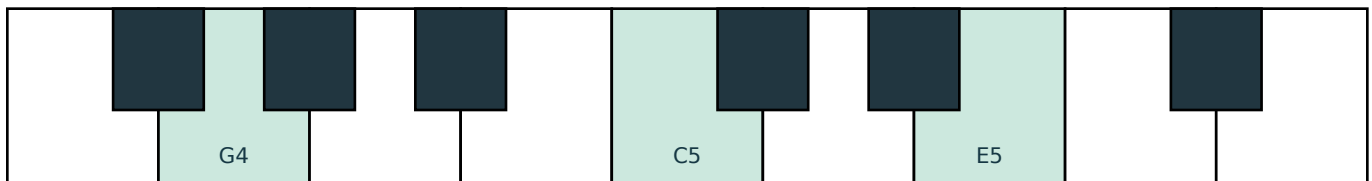
First inversion • C/E
