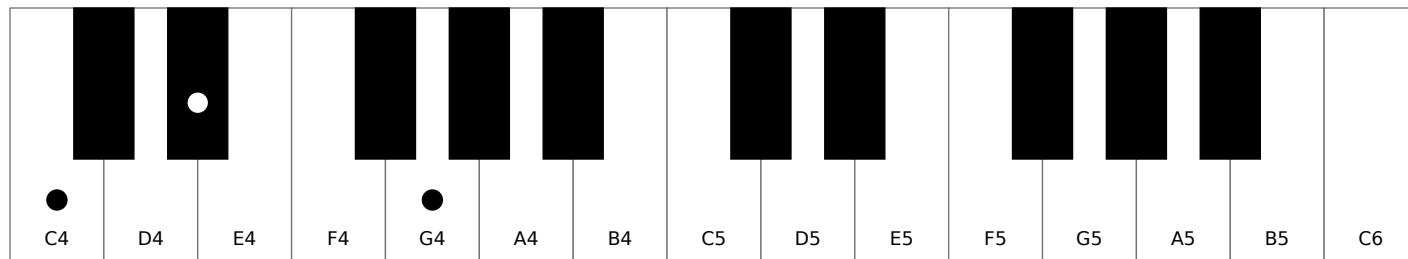

Bass: C4

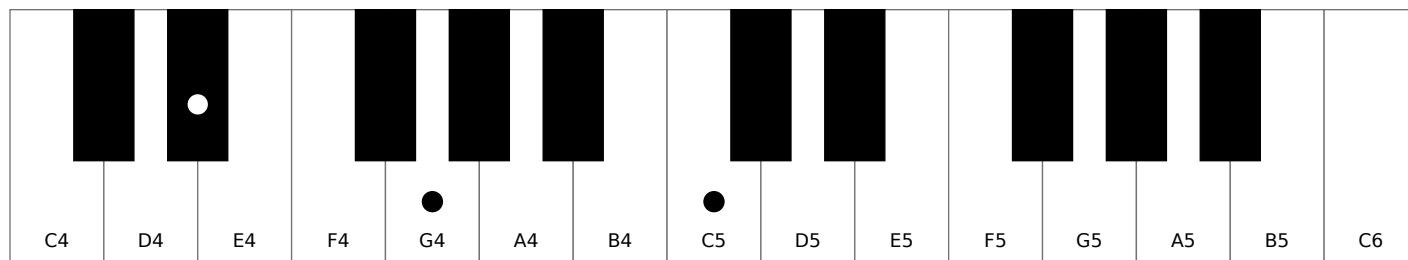
Selected pitches: C4 · E $\flat$ 4 · G4

Bass: E $\flat$ 4

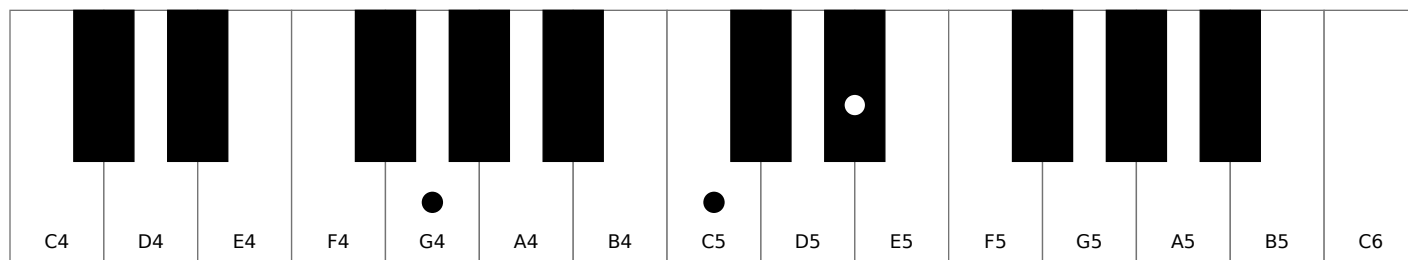
Selected pitches: E $\flat$ 4 · G4 · C5



Second inversion · Cm/G

Bass: G4

Selected pitches: G4 · C5 · E $\flat$ 5



Dots mark the sounding keys. Octave numbers are not finger numbers.

Each example keeps the chord tones but may use a different register.
