

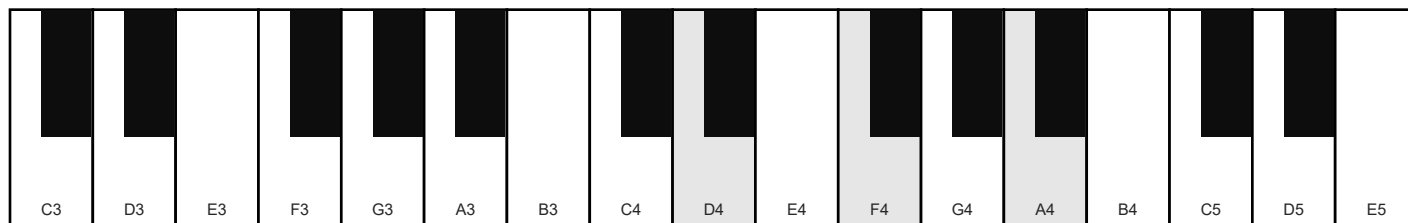

Root position · Dm

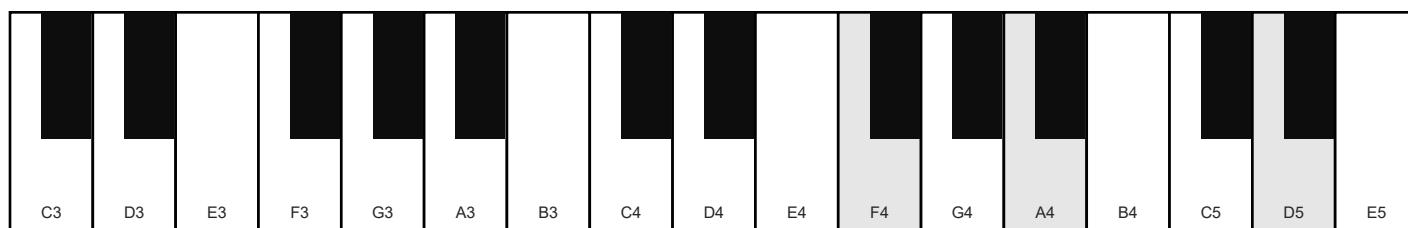
Bass: D4

First inversion · Dm/F

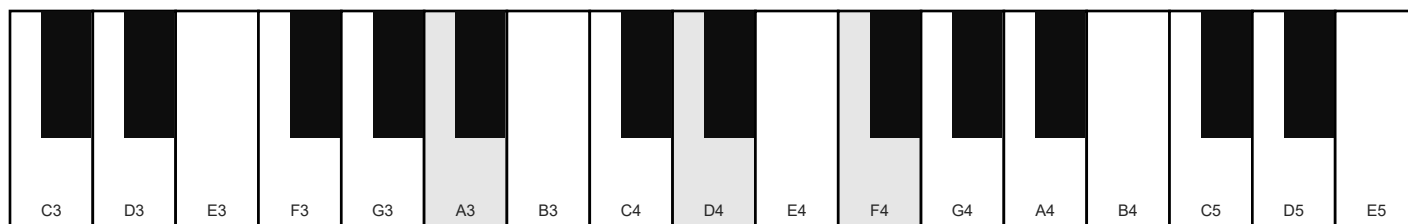
Bass: F4



Selected pitches: F4 · A4 · D5

Second inversion · Dm/A

Bass: A3



Selected pitches: A3 · D4 · F4

Dots and shading mark the sounding keys. Octave numbers are not finger numbers.

Each example keeps the chord tones but may use a different register.

No staff notation or hand-specific finger numbers are included in this PDF.

Keyboard window: C3–E5. Fingering is intentionally not assigned.
