

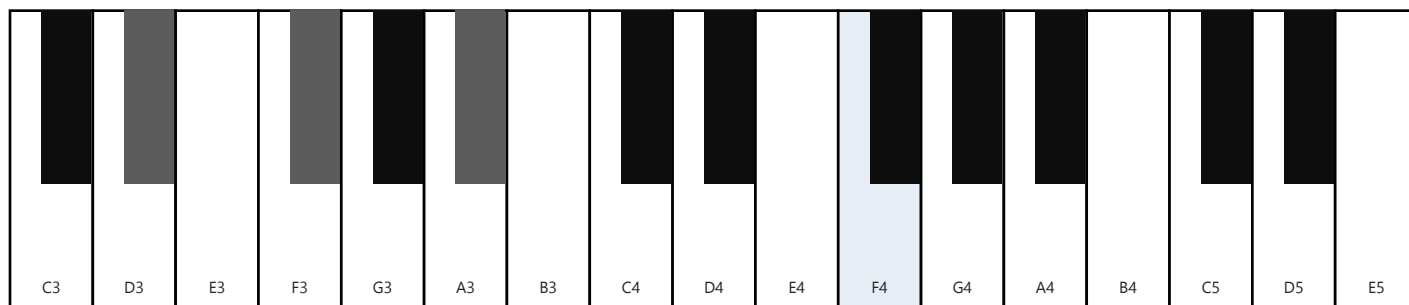
E-flat minor add9 (E $\flat$ m(add9))

Notes: E $\flat$ - G $\flat$ - B $\flat$ - F Formula: 1- $\flat$ 3-5-9

Two root-bass spacing examples. They are not a complete inversion catalogue.

Added note higher (9th layout) - E $\flat$ m(add9)

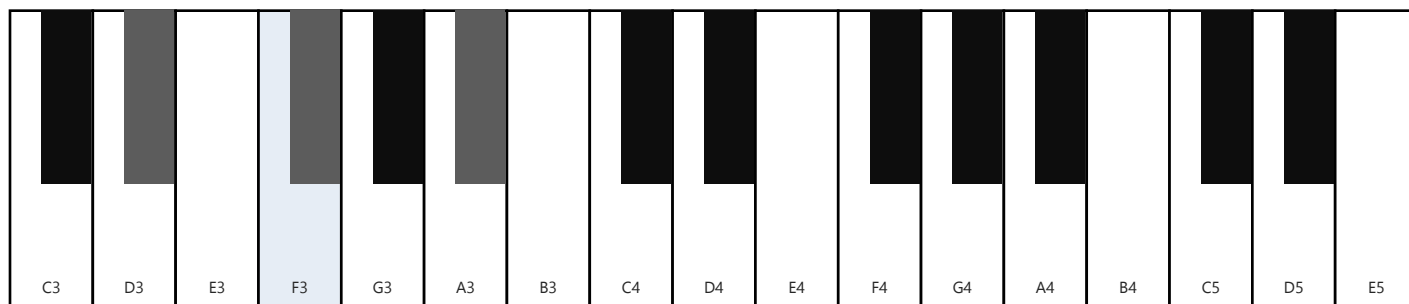
Bass: E $\flat$ 3



Selected pitches: E $\flat$ 3 - G $\flat$ 3 - B $\flat$ 3 - F4

Added note lower (2nd layout) - E $\flat$ m(add2)

Bass: E $\flat$ 3



Selected pitches: E $\flat$ 3 - F3 - G $\flat$ 3 - B $\flat$ 3

The higher example places the added member 14 semitones above the root; the inside example places it 2 semitones above.

Both examples keep the third and omit the seventh. Octave numbers identify register, not fingers.

Keyboard window: C3-E5. Written spelling is preserved. No fingering is assigned.

Theory scope: N2D v2 source ledger; formula-derived layouts passed package validation.
