

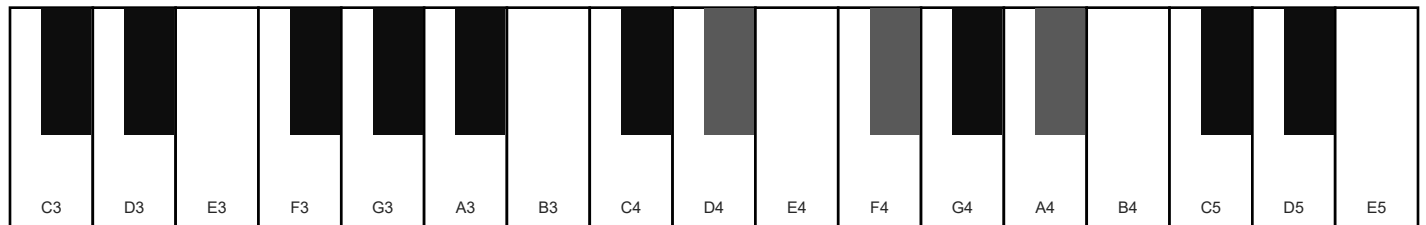
E♭ Minor (E♭m)

Exact pitch examples. Read left to right from the lowest note.

Root position · E♭m

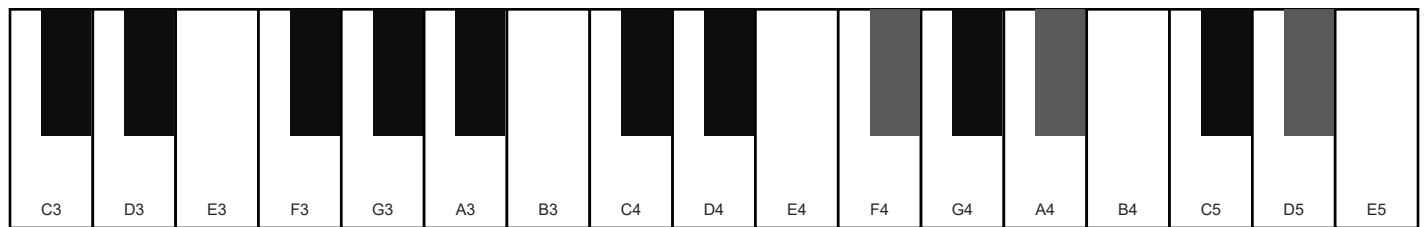
Bass: E♭4



Selected pitches: E♭4 · G♭4 · B♭4

First inversion · E♭m/G♭

Bass: G♭4



Selected pitches: G♭4 · B♭4 · E♭5

Second inversion · E♭m/B♭

Bass: B♭3



Selected pitches: B♭3 · E♭4 · G♭4

Dots and shading mark the sounding keys. Octave numbers are not finger numbers.

Each example keeps the chord tones but may use a different register.

No staff notation or hand-specific finger numbers are included in this PDF.

Keyboard window: C3–E5. Fingering is intentionally not assigned.
