

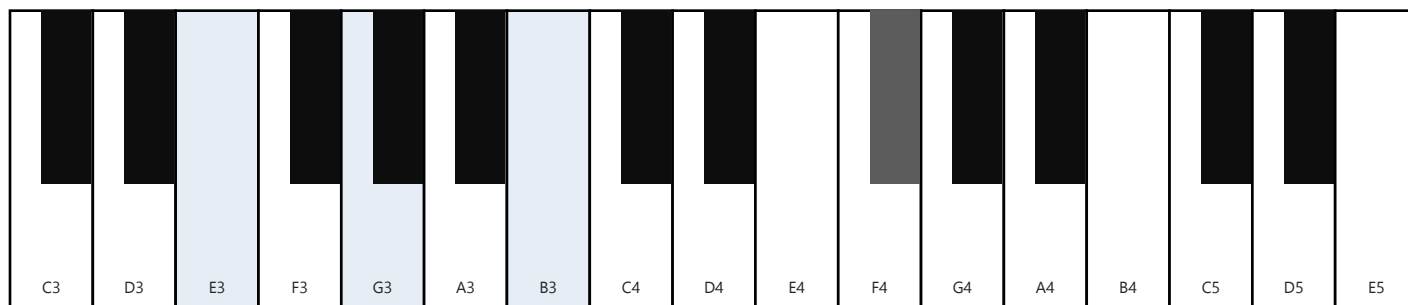
E minor add9 (Em(add9))

Notes: E - G - B - F $\sharp$ Formula: 1- $\flat$ 3-5-9

Two root-bass spacing examples. They are not a complete inversion catalogue.

Added note higher (9th layout) - Em(add9)

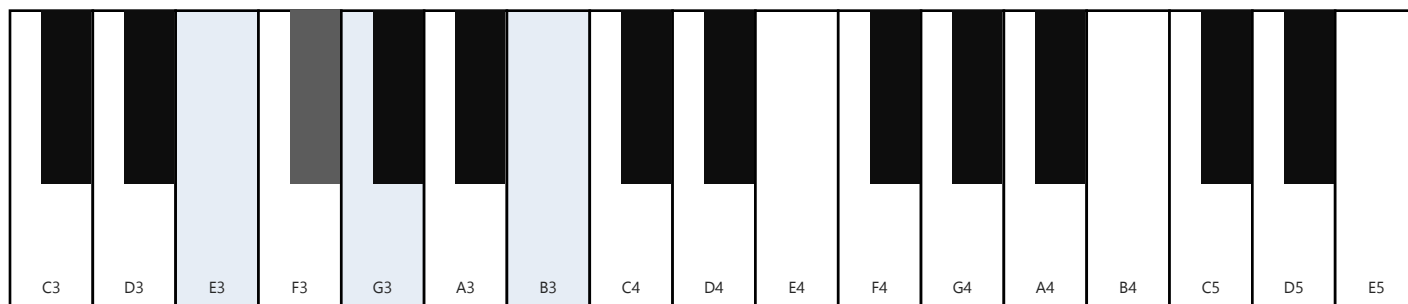
Bass: E3



Selected pitches: E3 - G3 - B3 - F $\sharp$ 4

Added note lower (2nd layout) - Em(add2)

Bass: E3



Selected pitches: E3 - F $\sharp$ 3 - G3 - B3

The higher example places the added member 14 semitones above the root; the inside example places it 2 semitones above.

Both examples keep the third and omit the seventh. Octave numbers identify register, not fingers.

Keyboard window: C3-E5. Written spelling is preserved. No fingering is assigned.

Theory scope: N2D v2 source ledger; formula-derived layouts passed package validation.
