

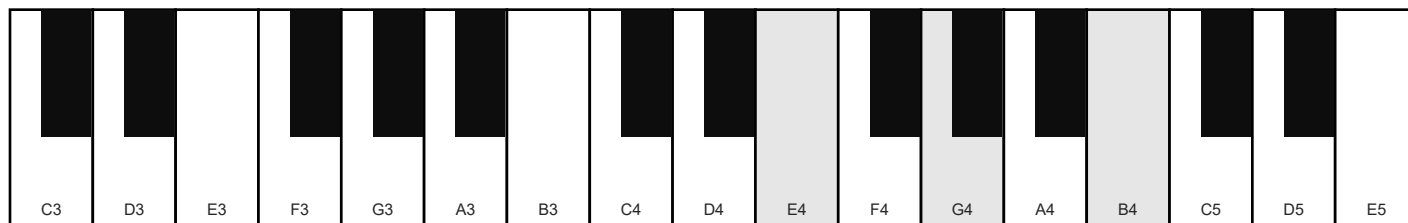

Root position · Em

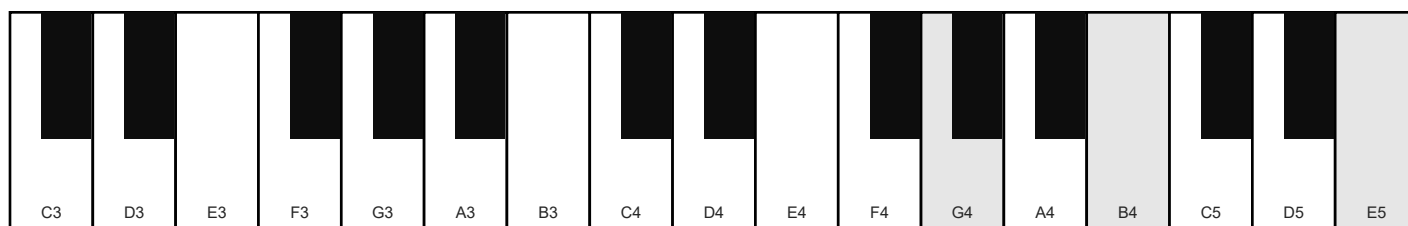
Bass: E4



Selected pitches: E4 · G4 · B4

First inversion · Em/G

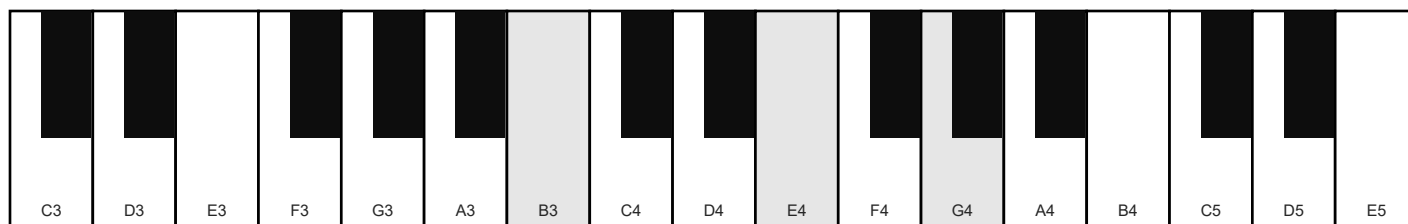
Bass: G4



Selected pitches: G4 · B4 · E5

Second inversion · Em/B

Bass: B3



Selected pitches: B3 · E4 · G4

Dots and shading mark the sounding keys. Octave numbers are not finger numbers.

Each example keeps the chord tones but may use a different register.

No staff notation or hand-specific finger numbers are included in this PDF.

Keyboard window: C3–E5. Fingering is intentionally not assigned.
