

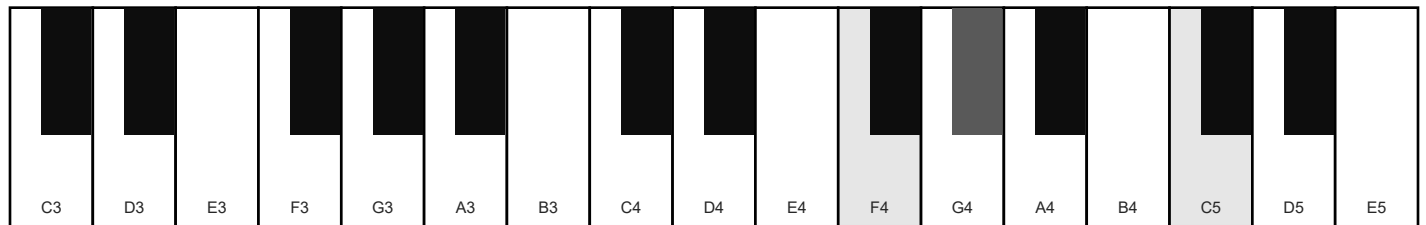
F Minor (Fm)

Root position · Fm

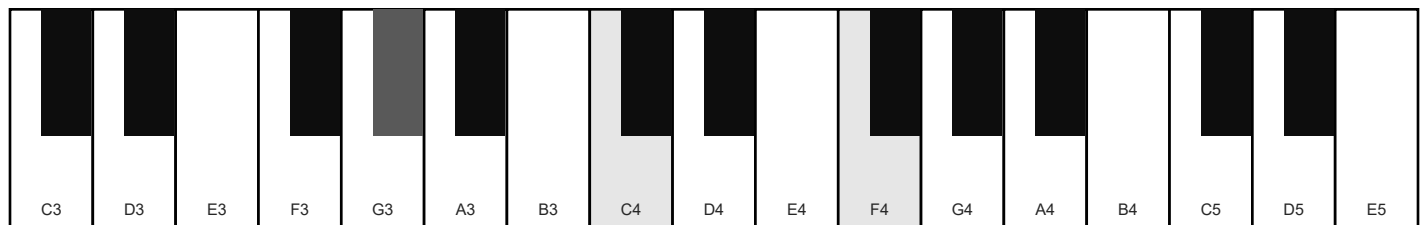
Bass: F4



Selected pitches: F4 · A $\flat$ 4 · C5

First inversion · Fm/A $\flat$

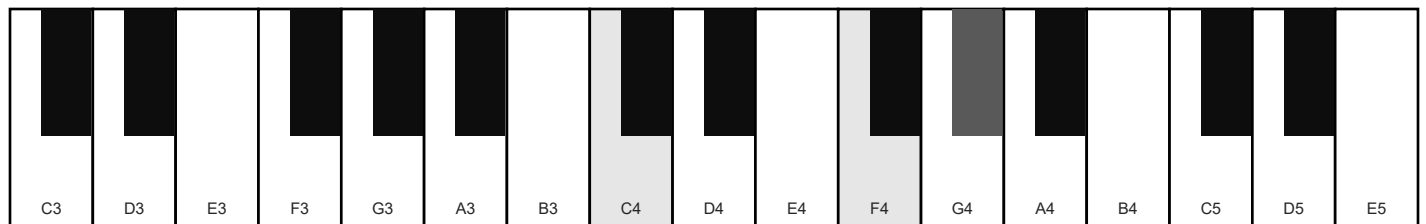
Bass: A $\flat$ 3



Selected pitches: A $\flat$ 3 · C4 · F4

Second inversion · Fm/C

Bass: C4



Selected pitches: C4 · F4 · A $\flat$ 4

Dots and shading mark the sounding keys. Octave numbers are not finger numbers.

Each example keeps the chord tones but may use a different register.

No staff notation or hand-specific finger numbers are included in this PDF.

Keyboard window: C3–E5. Fingering is intentionally not assigned.
