

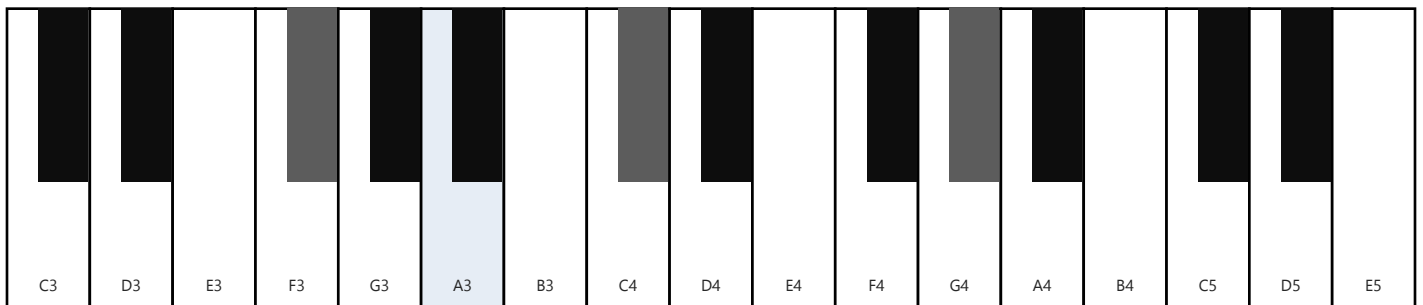
F-sharp minor add9 (F#m(add9))

Notes: F# - A - C# - G# Formula: 1-b3-5-9

Two root-bass spacing examples. They are not a complete inversion catalogue.

Added note higher (9th layout) - F#m(add9)

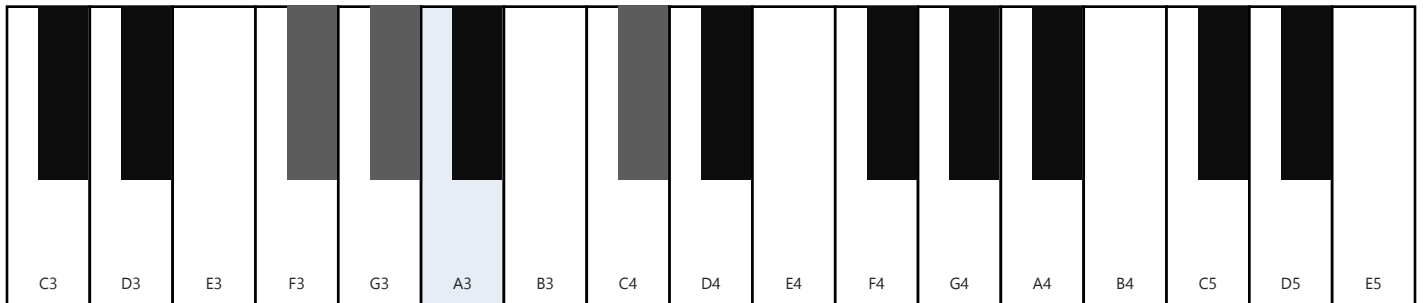
Bass: F#3



Selected pitches: F#3 - A3 - C#4 - G#4

Added note lower (2nd layout) - F#m(add2)

Bass: F#3



Selected pitches: F#3 - G#3 - A3 - C#4

The higher example places the added member 14 semitones above the root; the inside example places it 2 semitones above.

Both examples keep the third and omit the seventh. Octave numbers identify register, not fingers.

Keyboard window: C3-E5. Written spelling is preserved. No fingering is assigned.

Theory scope: N2D v2 source ledger; formula-derived layouts passed package validation.
