

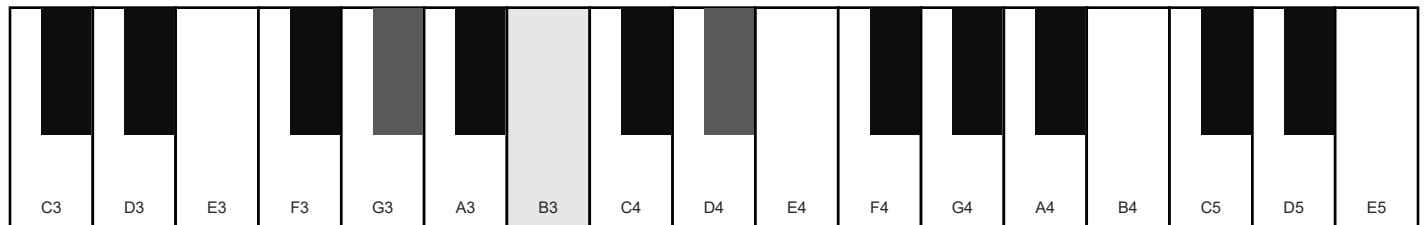
G# Minor (G#m)

Notes: G# – B – D# Formula: 1–♭3–5

Exact pitch examples. Read left to right from the lowest note.

Root position · G#m

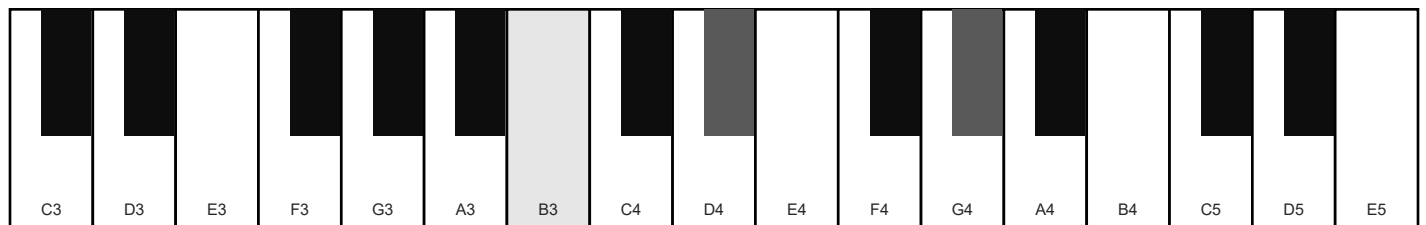
Bass: G#3



Selected pitches: G#3 · B3 · D#4

First inversion · G#m/B

Bass: B3



Selected pitches: B3 · D#4 · G#4

Second inversion · G#m/D#

Bass: D#4



Selected pitches: D#4 · G#4 · B4

Dots and shading mark the sounding keys. Octave numbers are not finger numbers.

Each example keeps the chord tones but may use a different register.

No staff notation or hand-specific finger numbers are included in this PDF.

Keyboard window: C3–E5. Fingering is intentionally not assigned.

Formula and notation rules: PG-TRIADS, PG-OMT and PG-ASPEN; package validation passed.
